Your 12-week marking period grade will be based on the following standards:

- Meeting deadlines: A1, A2
- Individual contribution: B1
- Formulation and analysis: C1, C2, C3, C4, C5, C6, C7
 - C7: A working “beta” implementation will suffice for a “Satisfactory” score
- Written report and presentation: D1, D2, D3, D4, D5, D6, D7

Your scores on the standards will be converted to a letter grade according to the conversion table in the course policy statement:
