Syllabus

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Course description. In this capstone course, students will work in teams on a semester-long project that applies operations research and statistical methods to real-world problems in the military, business, and society. Students will present their project work in a written report and in a presentation on USNA Capstone Day.

Course objectives. This course is the culmination of the operations research major. You will be required to manage a long-term project, during which you will:

- (1) formulate operations research and statistical models to solve a real-world problem,
- (2) analyze the results of these models to provide a recommendation,
- (3) communicate your formulation and analysis through both a written report and oral presentation.
