Your grade for the 12 week marking period will be based on the following standards:

- Meeting deadlines: all 3 standards
- Formulation and analysis (7 standards)
 - Identifying the problem
 - Identifying an appropriate modeling framework
 - Literature review
 - Identifying and analyzing inputs
 - Modeling assumptions
 - Correctness and complexity of model
 - Implementing the model
 - ◊ A working “beta” implementation using toy data will suffice for a “Satisfactory” score.
- Written report and presentation (8 standards)
 - Grammar, spelling, punctuation (GSP)
 - Organization
 - Clarity
 - Completeness
 - Tone
 - Technical language
 - Citations and references
 - Appearance and formatting (AF)

Your scores on the standards will be converted to a letter grade according to the conversion table in the course policy statement:
